The EURAMET General Assembly 2023 will be hosted by Metrosert from Tuesday, 30 May to Thursday, 2 June in Tallinn, Estonia. The participation fee for one day is 95 € (including VAT).

TRAVELING TO TALLINN BY AIR

Tallinn Airport is located just 4 km from the city centre, making the airport easily accessible. The airport has good public transport connections.

Tram to and from the airport

Tram line no. 4 stop is located on the city side of the passenger terminal of the airport. On Mondays to Saturdays, the first tram arrives at the airport at 5:25 AM. On Sundays at 5:45. The last tram from the airport leaves at 00:45 AM, allowing the passengers arriving on the late evening flights to reach the city centre by public transport.

The journey to the city centre takes approximately 15 to 17 minutes. Information about tram lines and stops can be found <u>HERE</u>.

A 1-hour ticket can be bought with a bankcard (1 hour 1,50 €) from the vehicle. Please enter from the front door. As you board a public transport vehicle, you will be required to validate your trip every time by swiping the card to the validator. If you see a green light, your trip has been validated.



By taxi

Getting to the airport by taxi is very convenient, as taxis stop at the car park in front of the passenger terminal.

The Estonian Academy of Sciences is in the Old Town and is not directly accessible by public transport. The walk from the hotels or from the nearest public transport connections to the meeting venue takes approx. 15 minutes. The meeting venue is also accessible by taxi.
